- 1. FULL BODY SCRUB, FRONT Use 3 Tbsp Scrub mixed with 10 pumps of Oil.
- 2. FACE CRADLE SCENT Remove hand towel over guest's eyes and tuck it under the face cradle. This allows your guest to smell the essence while they are facing down.
- 3. Flip guest over to FACE DOWN position.
- 4. FULL BODY SCRUB, BACK
- 5. Have guest rinse product in shower. Make sure to tell guest NOT to use Body Wash.

Hands

- 3 TSP: Manicure, 1 scoop: Pedicure Bath Soak
- 3 TSP Scrub: Manicure, 2 TBSP: Pedicure
- 1 TSP body oil + 1 TSP Butter (Mix together for massage)

- Guest chooses their color

 - Add Bath Soak to foot or hand soak
